**Syllabus and Study Notes for the MPF Intermediaries Examination /
MPF Schemes Examination (Eighth Edition)**

The Authority is pleased to announce that the Syllabus and Study Notes for the MPF Intermediaries Examination / MPF Schemes Examination (“Study Notes”) have been revised. The latest edition takes account of the following:

1. Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes (Amendment) Ordinance 2009
2. Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes (Amendment) Ordinance 2012
3. Latest developments in the MPF System

The Amendment Ordinance 2009 provides for an election by an employee to transfer the accrued benefits which arise from employee mandatory contributions made during their current employment to an MPF trustee and scheme of their own choice (i.e. the Employee Choice Arrangement). The Amendment Ordinance 2012 seeks to enhance the regulation of MPF sales and marketing activities for the implementation of the ECA.

The revisions also reflect latest developments in the MPF system such as changes to minimum and maximum levels of relevant income for the calculations of MPF contributions. We have also taken this opportunity to update other sections of the Study Notes.
