

## **The Government's Injection of Contributions into Eligible MPF/ORSO Scheme Members' Accounts [announced in the 2008-09 Budget]**

Pursuant to the announcement in the 2008-9 Budget on the captioned injection exercise and the relevant funding approval by Legislative Council Finance Committee in February 2009, the MPFA and relevant trustees have earlier sent cheques by mail to the following categories of persons for the injection of contributions of HK\$6,000:

- (1) Eligible scheme members who have withdrawn all MPF/ORSO accrued benefits on the grounds of "retirement, early retirement, total incapacity or permanent departure from Hong Kong" and have closed all relevant accounts.
- (2) Personal representatives of the estates of deceased eligible scheme members.

Some of the above-mentioned persons have not yet presented their cheques after the cheques have been issued to them for more than six months and the MPFA and relevant trustees have been unable to contact them, but in view of their eligibility for the injection, the MPFA will arrange to set up preserved accounts for them and inject the contributions into the accounts. The cheques issued previously will be voided.
