

- 5 An approved pooled investment fund refers to a type of investment fund into which a constituent fund invests.
- 6 An index-tracking collective investment scheme refers to a collective investment scheme which has the sole investment objective of tracking a particular market index.

Net Asset Values (NAV) and Contributions

As at 31.3.2025, the NAV of the MPF System amounted to \$1.34 trillion.



Tax-Deductible Voluntary Contributions (TVC)



Launched on 1.4.2019, the total number of TVC accounts reached $87\,000$ as at 31.3.2025. The cumulative total amount of contributions received since launch of TVC was $$12.87\ billion$

Default Investment Strategy (DIS)



As at 31.3.2025, **3.5 million** MPF accounts (i.e. about 31.2% of the total 11.3 million MPF accounts) with investment in DIS constituent funds, involving assets of **\$138.09 billion** (i.e. about 10.3% of the total NAV of MPF)


