Management

- Promote awareness and consciousness of environment protection and resources conservation;
- Implement green measures that minimize resources consumption, reduce waste, encourage recycling and conserve energy;
- Develop and apply environment friendly best practices to all operations as far as practicable; and
- Implement green procurement in contributing to environment sustainability.

Staff

- Observe green measures and environment friendly best practices and encourage others to do the same;
- Actively participate in training arranged by the MPFA on environment protection; and
- Report non-environment friendly behaviour/conditions and give suggestions on improvement.
