- Direct and monitor the implementation of IT plans and projects in collaboration with different business units;
- Oversee the development, maintenance and upgrading of MPFA's management information systems;
- Ensure the integrity, reliability, and security of systems and data;
- Identify emerging technologies and opportunities to enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of MPFA's systems and applications.
