

OCCUPATIONAL RETIREMENT SCHEMES ORDINANCE

APPLICATION FOR REGISTRATION FOR SCHEMES <u>NOT</u> PARTICIPATING IN A POOLING AGREEMENT

CLASSIFICATION OF SCHEMES

This Annexure is to assist the applicant to determine the category of schemes to which his scheme belongs and the types of documents which should be lodged with the application for registration.


The category can be identified by reference to the scheme's domicile, its administration arrangement and its benefits type. The combination of these various elements constitutes the category of the scheme as shown below. For example, a scheme which is domiciled in Hong Kong and is governed by trust and is of the defined contribution type is classified as Category 1A.

The documents required to be submitted with the application for registration are listed out under the column "Documents required for application" in the relevant category. In respect of these documents in the form of statement, undertaking or certificate, they should be prepared by persons having the qualification as described in Annexure II.

Please note that for certain documents, the Occupational Retirement Schemes (Authentication and Certification of Documents) Rules require them to be authenticated or certified in the manner prescribed therein.
