

## **Brief description of the revised Guidelines issued by MPFA in August 2020**

### *Guidelines on MPF Intermediary Registration and Notification of Changes (Guidelines VI.1)*

The MPFA has issued a set of revised MPF Guidelines. Guidelines VI.1 are revised in relation to (a) the specification of a new electronic form (i.e. the new Annex F to Guidelines VI.1) by the MPFA for use by a principal intermediary (PI) who intends to give the MPFA a notice of withdrawal of consent to a subsidiary intermediary attached to the PI for carrying on regulated activities for the PI; and (b) the publication of the information about the designation of the electronic system known as “eService” by the MPFA under section 6KA of the Mandatory Provident Fund Schemes Ordinance for submission of the new electronic forms by MPF intermediaries.
